

## Canvas Early Grade Performance Feedback with Canvas

In the fall and spring semesters, instructors have the opportunity to participate in the Early Performance Feedback process. Instructors are asked to assess whether a student's performance is Meeting Expectations and enter a Y (Yes) or N (No) for each student in their class. This information is disseminated to academic advisors and residence hall staff who reach out to students who are not meeting expectations in one or more of their courses. The ultimate goal is to help students use campus resources to enable them to improve their performance in a course.

Courses participating in the Early Performance Feedback will have a "Meets Expectations" notes column added to their course's Canvas grade book. Though students cannot view this column they can view their Early Performance Y/N information in a Canvas course under their Grades link.

#### **Instructors can:**

Manually enter a Y/N for each student in this column.

**Or** use the Early Performance Feedback web entry page to:

- **Option A:** Automatically populate the Meets Expectations column based on a letter grade or % score in the grade book.
- **Option B:** Export a .csv file version of their grade book, enter Y/N information in the .csv file. Upload the .csv file into the Early Performance Feedback web entry page which will populate the Y/N information into the Meets Expectations column in their Canvas grade book.

## **Option A Checklist:**

If you use **Option A** on the Early Performance Feedback web page:

## \_ Set the grading scheme in your Canvas course.

- Recommend you move Total column in grade book next to Meets Expectations column. (See next page for how to do this).
- In Canvas grade book click "Early Performance Input" button. Login with eID.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Select the course in which to enter Y/N into the Meets Expectations grade book column.

\_\_\_\_\_ If you have **cross listed/combined 2 or more course in Canvas**, on the Early Grade Feedback web entry page, **only select the parent course from the drop down** 

**menu.** This will enter a Y or N <u>for all students in all sections</u> in the combined / cross listed Canvas course, based on the <u>grading scheme you set in the parent Canvas course</u>.

\_\_\_\_ Go to Canvas grade book and verify Y/N were assigned appropriately.


## **Two Options:**

## A: Automatically Populate Y/N in Meets Expectations column.

## **Prerequisites:**


- 1. <u>Set grading scheme in your Canvas course.</u>
- 2. Recommend that you temporarily move the Total column in your grade book so that it appears next to the Meets Expectations column; easier to verify how Y/N's are assigned.

In your grade book, on the far right, use the drop down menu next to the Total column and select Move to front.



This will allow you to quickly see total points or percentage and verify that Y and N's are assigned correctly. You can move the Total back to the far right (end) after you are done.

To assign a **Y/N value** for your students in the **Meets Expectations column** in your grade book **please go to your Canvas course.** 



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- 3) *Enter* your **CSU eID** user name and password.
- 4) Use the **drop down menu** under "*Select your course*" to select which of your courses you wish to enter Y/N information.

- 5) Click on **Option A** to expand / see options.
- 6) Under Step 1 select one of the Population Criteria.

#### Option A: Automatically Populate

Step 1: Select one of these methods.

O Assign a Y to all students whose current letter grade in the gradebook Total column

is at least C v. Assign an N to all others.

Assign a Y to all students whose current percent score in the gradebook Total column

is at least 70 %. Assign an N to all others.

Assign a Y to all students whose final percent score in the gradebook Total column

is at least %. Assign an N to all others.

To see final scores in the gradebook, click the 🌣 menu and select "Treat Ungraded as 0". 🗇

Assign a Y to all students.

You can then manually enter an N for students who do not have satisfactory progress in your course.

Remove all Y/N values from the Meets Expectations column.

9) On the left menu *click* **Grades** to refresh your grade book and see the populated Y/N information under the Meets Expectations column.



1) In your Canvas Grade Book, at the top right, *click* Export, Current.

2) *Save* the **downloaded** .csv file of your grade book to your computer.

3) *Open* the **.csv file** you downloaded with MS Excel.




5) In the **Meets Expectations column** *enter* **Y**/**N**'s for your students.

6) *Save* your file as a .csv file.



7) On the left **course menu** in your Canvas course *click* **Grades**.



8) At the top right of the grade book *click* **Early Performance Input.**

- 10) *Use* the **drop down menu** under "**Select your course**" to select which of your courses you wish to enter Y/N information.

- 11) *Click* **Option B: Upload an Excel .csv** file to expand this option.
- 12) Click Browse and locate the .csv file with your Meets Expectations Y/N values.
- 13) Click Upload.

#### Option B: Upload an Excel .csv file

Step 1: Export grades from the Canvas Gradebook to a .csv file C

**Step 2:** Edit the .csv file using Excel Add a column named Meets Expectations, enter y or n for each student in the column, and Save. (In Excel you can enter a y for the first student, fill down with y and change a few to n, or use an Excel formula like =IF(Z3>=70,"y","n") where Z is the Current Score column.)

Step 3: Upload the .csv file here The S/U information in the Early Check column in the .csv file will be copied to the Meets Expectations column in your Canvas course.

A Important: Do not import this file directly into the Canvas gradebook.

14) *Return* to your **Canvas course**.

15) On the left menu *click* **Grades** to refresh your grade book and see the populated Y/N information under the Meets Expectations column.

Note: You can manually change a Y or N value for a student in the Meets Expectations column.

## What Can Students See?

Under the **Grades link** in a participating EPF Canvas course, a student can *click* on the "**View My Early Performance**" to see if they received a Y or N in that course.
